Amber Jackson is a Member-at-Large for the Habematolel Pomo of Upper Lake, a federally recognized Indian Nation located in Upper Lake, California. Member-at-Large Jackson was first elected to the Tribe's seven-member Executive Council in 2010. She was then re-elected in 2018 to fill a vacancy position. As a Member-at-Large, Jackson represents the General Membership, Tribal Government and sovereign enterprises where she is tasked with the overall care of the Tribe, the success of their committees and business operations. In her role she serves on multiple Tribal committees where her efforts are focused on providing adequate housing for Tribal Members and opportunities for their youth.

Prior to her election with the Executive Council she was a Security Supervisor for Running Creek Casino. She served on the Parent Advisory Committee and the Seven Generation Scholarship Fund Selection Committee for the Tribe. Member-at-Large Jackson is currently an appointed delegate for the Tribe at California Tribal College.

Dedicated to her own traditional native values and culture, Member-at-Large Jackson strongly believes in service to her Tribe. She has served on several committees, attended many meetings regarding the Tribe and voted in every election. She continues to volunteer her time to the Tribe and helping them become successful. Member-at-Large Jackson believes that the Tribal youth are the most important resources and feels that regardless of their socioeconomic status they deserve as many opportunities as possible.

She currently resides in Lucerne, California. Member-at-Large Jackson is a mother of six children and a grandmother to six grandchildren.
