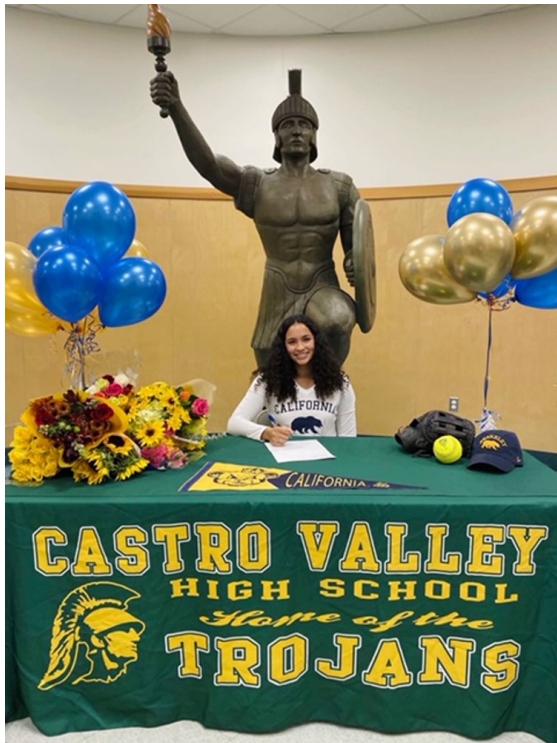

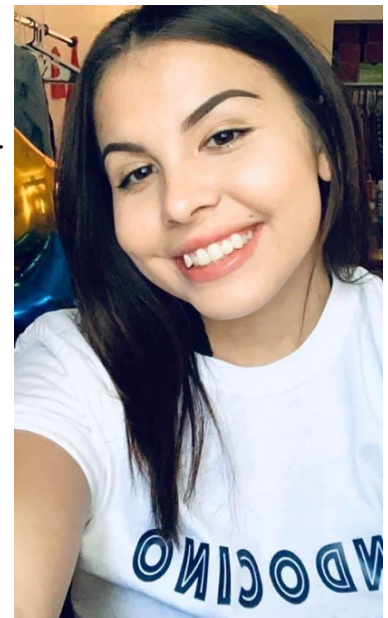

In the fall, she will be attending UC Berkeley, where she has accepted a position on the softball team and has the intention to major in Psychology.



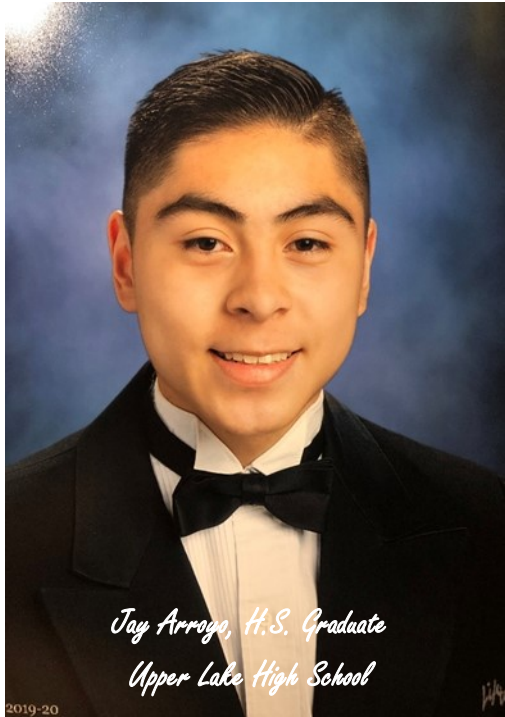

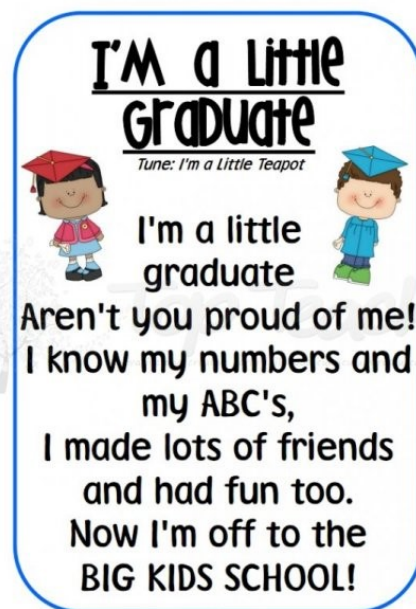
Mentor, Silver Viking Award, School Letter Award, Integrity Award, Empathy Award all while being a star athlete-basketball, softball and volleyball.

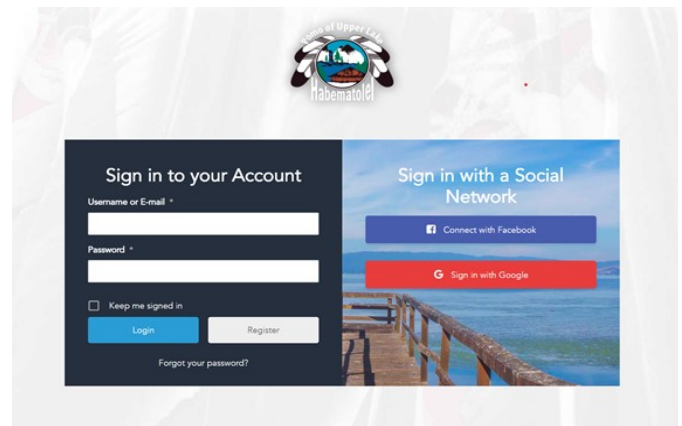
Via the Internet enter the Tribe's new website address: <https://www.hpultribe-nsn.gov/>
