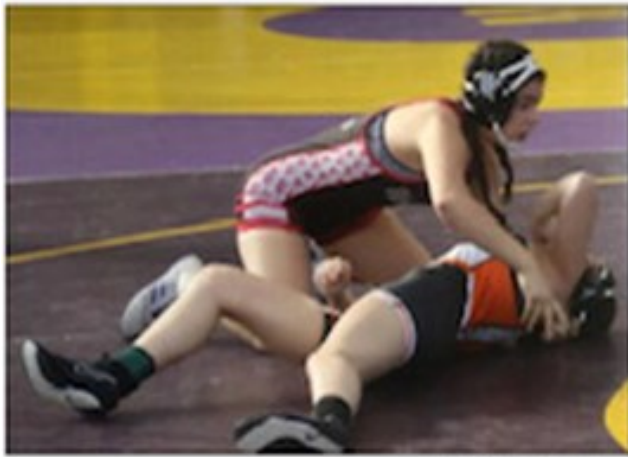




WINTER WONDER
