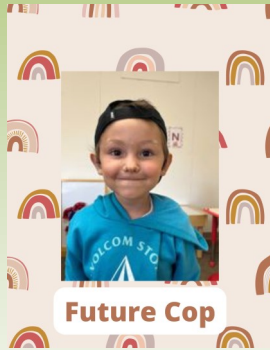




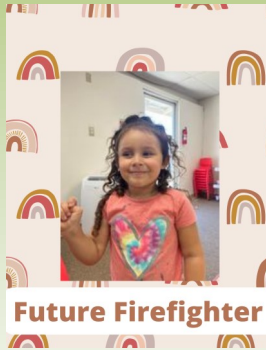
## PRESCHOOL IS IN SESSION!!
