- ◇ YOUTH OF THE MONTH-chosen for “personal growth” (i.e. self-improvement, leadership, or sportsmanship).

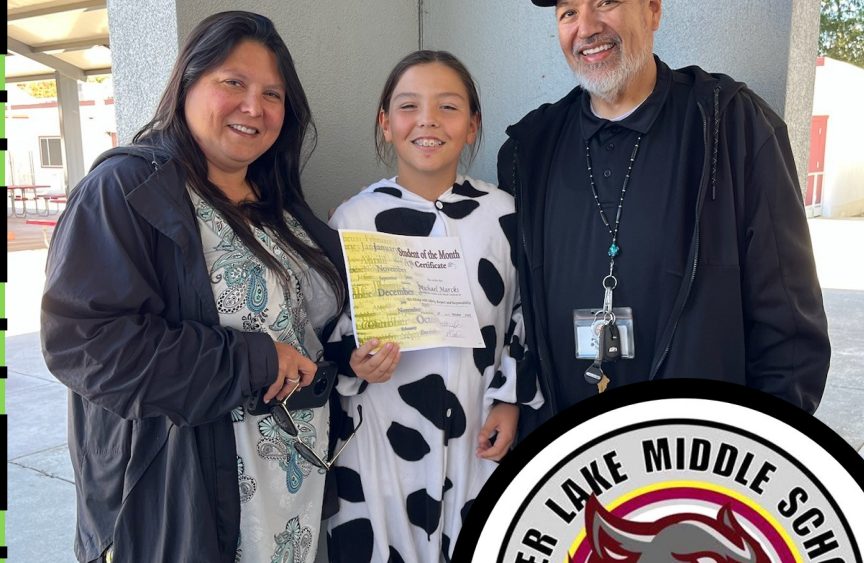
