



**HABEMATOLEL POMO OF  
UPPER LAKE TRIBAL COURT  
APPEAL CASE FILING  
FLOW CHART**

Judgment Issued in Tribal Court or by a decision of the Election Board or Enrollment Committee



Notice of Appeal is filed within 30 Days of entry of Final Order

If the Appeal is LATE, the appeal MUST include a written request to accept a late appeal and provide an explanation as to why there is good cause for the Tribal Court of Appeals to accept the late Appeal



If GRANTED by the Chief Justice, the Record on Appeal is Transmitted to the Appellate Court

The Court of Appeals has 10 Days to decide if the Notice of Appeal is legally sufficient. If the Appeal is REJECTED, then the matter will be closed



Case Management conference is scheduled, and the parties noticed



Preparation & Filing of briefs by the Appellant & Appellee within the timeframe set forth on the Case Management Order



Any motions filed by due date on Case Management Order are heard on the date set for the final pre-trial



The Tribal Court of Appeals MAY send an order setting an oral argument or decline to set an oral argument



Decision is rendered by the Appellate Court  
(Judgment Affirmed, Reversed, or Remanded to the Trial Court)
