Cultural workshops included Medallions, Tule Dolls, Basket weaving, Feathers/Knots, Traditional Medicine & Beading.



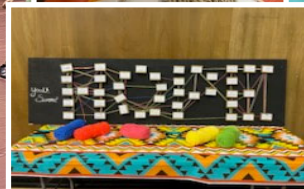

Traditional Medicine

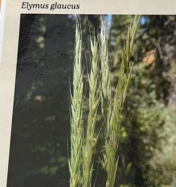


Identification
Short, wide perennial herb standing 1-2 feet tall.
• Pale green, lacy leaves
• 4 orange petals

Habitat
Grassy and open areas from sea level to 10,000 feet altitude in the western United States, extending to southern Washington, Nevada, Arizona, Mexico, and the Sonoran and northern areas of Mexico.

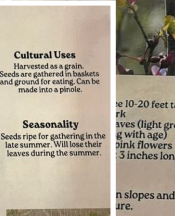
Ecological Communities: Annual Chaparral

Blue Wild Rye



Identification
Deciduous bunchgrass 20-60 inches tall.
• Spring: Blue-green with white waxy coating
• Summer: Dries out and turns yellow
• Wide, flat leaves 2-5 inches wide that fall off in the summer
• Seed heads that look similar to wheat

Habitat
Ingrazed by deer and other animals. Grows in oak woodlands.



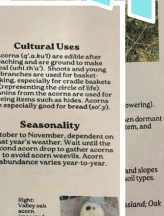
Valley Oak



Identification
Large deciduous oak tree (the largest of the California oaks).
• Highly lobed, bright green leaves with a fuzzy coating
• Mature acorns are large (1.5-2 in long) and tapered
• Bark is gray-brown, thick, and ridged

Habitat
Close to water sources and at lower elevations. Needs full sun.

Ecological Communities: Oak Woodland

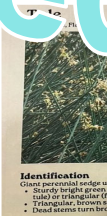


Identification
Shrub 10-20 feet tall with light green leaves (light green with pink flowers) 3 inches long.

Seasonality
Seeds ripe for gathering in the late summer. Will lose their leaves during the summer.

Cultural Uses
Harvested as a grain. Seeds are gathered in baskets and ground for eating. Can be made into a pinole.

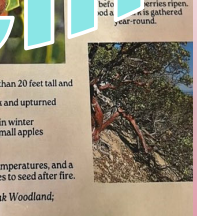
