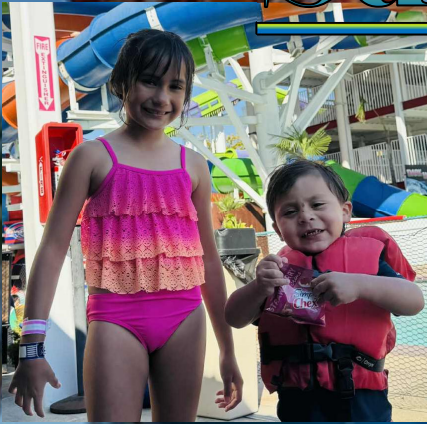


Mason received the Star Award for his honesty and his continuous hard work in his homework. He arrives everyday and always starts his homework without being asked.
