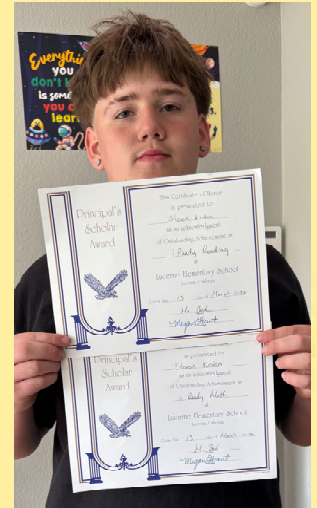
## Achievements
